ISESS, the International Symposium on Environmental Software Systems, was initiated in 1995 as a forum for presenting and discussing the fundamentals, progress and trends in terms of methods, tools and state-of-the-art environmental informatics applications. Over the years, it has also evolved into an important networking tool for academics, environmental professionals, and other interested parties.

ISESS is a conference series organized on behalf of the International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP), WG 5.11 “Computers and Environment”. In odd-numbered years, ISESS is held as a conference with a complete range of topics related to Environmental Information Systems (EIS) and related topics. In even-numbered years ISESS is held as a workshop of the biennial meetings of the International Environmental Modelling and Software Society (IEMSS).

The 2013 conference is organised by the Austrian Institute of Technology in cooperation with IFIP, the European Commission and the European Environment Agency.
